

Guild Building Transformation



William M. Barnum Associates was hired as the architect for the redesign of the Guild Building into a permanent church home for St. Andrew's by-the-Sea, and construction began in the summer of 1997.



The major exterior work involved construction of the narthex and bell tower/steeple. The steeple was fully assembled before being raised over the narthex. The sea bass weather vane was its crowning touch.
